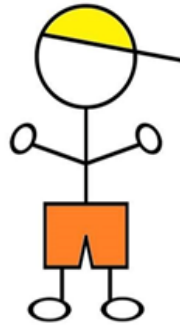




# CAP-IT Newsletter

### Recruitment update

Total = 64 patients (45 PED; 20 WARD).

### Study updates

- The protocol is undergoing ethical and regulatory review, with amendments including changes to eligibility criteria and to some study documents, including:
  - ◇ Combined PED and WARD Patient Information Sheet and Summary
  - ◇ Combined PED and WARD consent form
  - ◇ Study Medicine Information Sheet
- The CAP-IT parent information film will also be introduced as part of this amendment so please start thinking about how best this can be used to aid recruitment at your sites.
- Protocol amendment and database training sessions will run in the weekly site call slots—dates coming soon.

**IMP** — When ordering IMP please order PED and WARD stock at the same time—MRC CTU pay per shipment.
